Who is a Carer?

If you look after a relative, friend or neighbour who could not manage without help because of sickness, age or disability, then you are a **carer**.

It is acknowledged that the greatest share of community care is done by Britain's six million carers within the isolation of their own homes.

In recent years the word "carer" has come to mean someone other than a paid worker who cares for an ill, frail or disabled person.

Many people do not think of themselves as carers, however identifying yourself as a carer is a way of acknowledging that you do a job and may also help you to access services that can assist you in your caring role.
