PE T-shirts

Following feedback from parents about the difficulty of keeping our white PE t-shirts clean, we are moving to a navy blue t-shirt with a red badge, in the same style, from September 2017.

Children will still wear their white t-shirts this term and can continue to wear these until they grow out of them.

The new navy blue t-shirts will be available from the last week of July for a September 2017 phase-in for all year groups, except the new Reception intake who will remain in white until next year.

The new navy blue t-shirts will cost £7.00. The existing white t-shirt will be increasing in cost to £6.70 with immediate effect, following supplier price increases.

Red PE Shorts

For all new orders we are moving with immediate effect to a straighter, less A-line style of red shorts, again based on parental feedback and sports styles across

different schools. Children may continue to wear the existing red shorts until they require a new pair. The new shorts will cost £7.00.

Jumper/Cardigan Quality

We have received consistent parent comment that the quality of jumpers and cardigans is not as good as it used to be. However, they come from the same supplier and are made from the same material, 100% acrylic.

They do not require fabric conditioner when washing, as this makes them shiny or ironing, which makes them limp.
