At the beginning of July we have the great joy in our diocese of celebrating the ordination of two new priests. Gary Carter and our own Scott Coleman will be ordained by Bishop Richard at Arundel Cathedral on Saturday 5th July at 12noon. All are welcome.

The new priests will celebrate their first Masses at Walton and Molesey. Scott will offer the 11am Solemn Mass on Sunday 6th July. We have been working hard on the preparations for the liturgy! Our desire to be in the right disposition to receive Holy Communion is a witness to our faith in the Real of Presence of Jesus Christ. He is here! Body, blood, soul, divinity. Under this form, He gives Himself to us completely. We worship the Sacred Mystery, not as symbol, but as Our Lord and Our God.
