Smartie the Penguin has lots of tips on how to stay safe including what children should do if they come across anything which makes them feel uncomfortable.

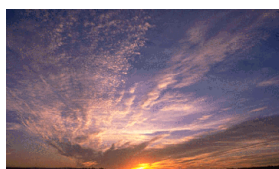
