At the beginning of July we have the great joy in our diocese of celebrating the ordination of two new priests. Gary Carter and our own Scott Coleman will be ordained by Bishop Richard at Arundel Cathedral on Saturday 5th July at 12noon. All are welcome.

The new priests will celebrate their first Masses at Walton and Molesey. Scott will offer the 11am Solemn Mass on Sunday 6th July. We have been working hard on the preparations for the liturgy! After Mass there will be a drinks & canapes reception in the parish field. I shall speak again about this occasion this weekend; suffice it to say this is an amazing event in the history of our parish as we witness a first Mass being offered in Molesey.
