Dear Parishioners, dear friends,

Last week's gospel left us with the words of Our Lord hanging in air pregnant with faith and love. I am he says Jesus to the sinful but searching woman of Samaria. This week the man born blind shows us that the search is truly a work of faith and demands the response not just of the senses but of the who person. I am the one declares the man born blind: yes he has responded, he believes.

Dismissed by others, the buck even passed by his parents he says with all resolution 'I am the man'. For Jesus has touched his life, opened his eyes but more deeply enlightened him with faith. I am the man...

The response of others is superficial. This is a man born blind and now he can see? How can that be? He was cured on an inappropriate day for such work, that is surely not right. He must be a sinner why else would he be so disadvantaged? The action of Jesus reaches below the surface and meets the man in the rawness of his existence.
