### **Diocesan Pastoral Plan and the Weybridge Deanery**

Bishop Richard shared his Pastoral Plan and vision for our diocese in January 2024. In time our deanery will become a single 'parish of communities.' A Steering Group was set up, with Canon Chris Spain of Egham as the Moderator, and is now meeting regularly to discern ways forward. The group, consisting

of clergy and lay people, is looking at how we embed the principles and vision of the Pastoral Plan, recognising that the roles of clergy will evolve, also how we provide support for parish communities and mission.

Rooted in a vision of love and of a missionary church, please pray for the steering group as it meets over the coming months.

### **CAFOD FAMILY FAST DAY FRIDAY**

**14 MARCH** Thank you again to our parishioners for your generous support in CAFOD's work throughout the world. As you know we have two annual appeals at Lent and Harvest.

This year the appeal publicity is a celebration of the changes your donations have made to our neighbours in Kenya.

CAFOD works with local partners and that means that local experts and agencies work together to make our donations help more people.

Lokho lost all her livestock following a drought and could no longer feed her family. Wakera, a local agricultural expert worked with Lokho, and other families. He shared his skills in growing suitable crops in harsher environments and with donations from CAFOD provided seeds, tools, shade nets and knowledge to create kitchen gardens. These communities successfully provided food for their families and excess to sell in markets. (Shade nets protect plants from the scorching sun but also collect every drop of rainwater; a reverse greenhouse)

2025 is the Jubilee Year of HOPE and Pope Francis asks us to be "Pilgrims of Hope". Please continue to support the work of CAFOD with our neighbours worldwide to fight poverty, injustice and restore hope.
