Dear Parishioners, dear friends,

Ash Wednesday is this Wednesday and marks
the beginning of Lent. We are marked with a
sprinkling of ashes on the head, we remember
that we are dust and to dust we shall return.

From the dust of the earth, we read in the story
of Creation, that man was fashioned and the
life of the Creator was breathed in him. In the
waters of baptism we were reborn in Christ
Jesus and the life of His Resurrection was
breathed into our souls.

These beautiful mysteries of our faith – our
creation and redemption – are the focus of our
Lenten observance. We seek to strip away all
that distracts us from who we really are and
find again our identity and integrity in Christ.
