The Church's history turns another page as the city of Rome prepares for a new bishop and the Universal Church prepares for a new pope. This is a wonderful time as we hear again the words of the Lord *Tu es petrus*, You are Peter, and on this rock I shall build my Church. Please be generous in your prayers for the cardinals and especially for those in the sacred college who are considered and have to face the possibility that they themselves might be the next pope.

Diocesan Pastoral Plan and the Weybridge Deanery

Bishop Richard shared his Pastoral Plan and vision for our diocese in January 2024. In time our deanery will become a single 'parish of communities.' A Steering Group was set up, with Canon Chris Spain of Egham as the Moderator, and is now meeting regularly to discern ways forward. The group, consisting of clergy and lay people, is looking at how we embed the principles and vision of the Pastoral Plan, recognising that the roles of clergy will evolve, also how we provide support for parish communities and mission.


