Fr Bill writes: I would like to take this opportunity to wish all parishioners a holy and blessed Easter. It will be even better when congregations are allowed to sing. Thanks also go to the children who submitted their art work connected with Holy Week and Easter. Easter Eggs will be on their way or are available for collection.

In the post Easter period there will be Exposition and Confessions after the 9.30 am Mass on Saturdays. This will start on Saturday 10th April.

Live Streaming: you will have noticed the unpredictability of the transmission of the streamed Masses in the last week. BT visited the site on Wednesday and confirmed that there is a fault in the line outside the property that will have to be fixed by BT Openreach. They hope they have now resolved the problem and we hope it will all settle down again.

Confessions: I will be available for Confessions after Mass on Saturday 20th and 27th March and 3rd April for an hour. I will locate myself in the sacristy.

I have outlined a draft schedule for the delivery of the **First Reconciliation and First Communion Programme** that enables us to complete the celebrations before the start of August. The first Communion Masses will still be scheduled for Saturday afternoons but it is possible that some of the social distancing measures will have been relaxed by the time for the first Mass of the four scheduled in July.
