SVP Prayer Shawl Ministry

Our St Vincent de Paul group would love to bring the American tradition of knitting prayer shawls for loved ones or those in need to our parish. There are three parts to this:

(1) production of knitted/crochet items at home, (2) assembly of blankets from knitted/crochet squares, this will involve getting together for a couple of hours once a month to work together and chat and pray over tea and cake, and (3) Distribution to those in need of prayer, companionship or just keeping warm, remembering that this winter many people were very cold and next winter may not be much different.

If you can knit or crochet, please make 6in (15cm) squares which will be assembled into lap blankets or shawls. Alternatively, other small items can be produced such as hats, scarves, gloves or fingerless mittens. Don't know how to knit/crochet, but want to? No problem - tuition can be provided!
