Even where the teacher has not set work children may access the Learning Library (Activities link on their page) and access any of their activities they choose.



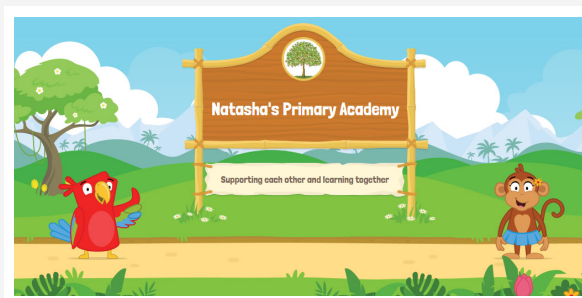
Create

Keeping Safe



Responsible & kind sharing

It is important that children are kind to one another online just as much as being kind offline. That means they should only post comments that are kind and caring.



Don't overshare

Children should stay safe by not sharing their personal information online, even in DB Primary. Don't post your phone number, address or email contact details on DB Primary.



Do not arrange to meet

It is important that children know they shouldn't set up meetings online. They never know who they are speaking with.



Always logout when finished

Most cases where a password or account is compromised happens in the home. Make sure your child's account is protected. Always log out and don't share details with other family members.

Remember the account may be deactivated if misused.
