Please practise these daily!

Daily reading – Adults please record in reading record books

If they are struggling with a piece of work- STOP! The children are reminded to see us if they don't understand homework (not on the day it's due!)



Encourage reading as much as possible, read both fiction and non fiction.

Your child is to read aloud to an adult every day

Question whilst reading to check for understanding

Add a comment (on their reading) in their reading records (focus on comprehension, punctuation, intonation, recount, what will happen next?)



Spelling – LEARN the words! Not just 'write three times' Write a sentence for the weekly chosen words

Saying spellings aloud
Look for other words that follow the pattern
One spelling column per day

Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check!

## **Accelerated Reader**

Online assessment and regular quizzes to gauge comprehension skills

At the end of each book children take a quick quiz on the computer

We ask each child to quiz regularly as this enables them to reach the next level
