SEASON OF CREATION - 1 September-4 October Seeds of peace and hope

Under the leadership of Pope Francis, and now of Pope Leo, this season focusses on God as Creator of the vast universe, God's revelation in Creation, and our response to our calling to care for Creation and address the urgent need to protect it. The theme reminds us that many human activities amount to a "war against Creation". The mission before us as people of faith is to work for the justice and global solidarity that are essential to establishing peace with Creation.

In our parish, we shall be marking this Season, ending with the Feast of St Francis of Assisi on 4 October, with a variety of prayers and activities as follows:

- Throughout the Season, we shall focus on Creation during Adoration on Tuesday evenings.
- On 21st Sep in in Children's Liturgy, our children will plant flowers and create a banner.
- On 20-21 Sept there will be a dedicated Mass for Creation.
- On 27-28 September we will listen to a CAFOD appeal, and Family Fast Day will take place on 3 October.
- On 4-5 October we will be collecting food for the Walton and Hersham foodbank as part of our Harvest Thanksgiving.
- And, finally, we'll be celebrating the Feast of St Francis of Assisi on 4 October, with more details to follow.
