WELCOME TO MASS Readings and
prayers are found in the Parish Missals for Fifth
Sunday of Easter.

Dear Parishioners, dear friends,

The Acts of the Apostles is an extraordinary account of the Church in the aftermath of the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Beginning with a reference to the Gospel of Luke (My earlier work Theophilus...), Acts takes up the story with the outpouring of the Holy Spirit and ends with the inevitable death of Peter and Paul in Rome.

However, there are two great partnerships in Acts - Peter and John and Paul and Barnabas. This Sunday we pick up the story of Paul and Barnabas as they stage at Antioch. There, we are told, fresh heart is their gift to the Church in Antioch. 'Encouraging them to persevere in the faith....' The backstory seems to be that there are many hardships that have been experienced amongst this community.

Hardship is a feature of all our lives. Sometimes we hear of, and even experience, great hardship. Our personal challenges and difficulties are often unspoken and

All of us are surely mindful of those huge sweeps of human tragedy: our minds are constantly on the appalling situation in Ukraine and our prayers are continuously offered for peace. All of us too, have a responsibility to do what we can to put new heart into those who simply need encouraging on our own doorstep.

These situations of encouragement are a constant theme of the book of the Acts of the Apostles. Indeed, we might say that encouragement is an apostolic charism! But we must never shy away from the normality of what it is to give another encouragement, to build them up rather than drag them down, to meet their need, rather than simply ignore it.

May Paul, Apostle of the Gentiles and Teacher of the nations and Barnabas, son of encouragement, pray for us all

STORY BEHIND MISSIO

The venerable Pauline Jaricot, one the founders of Missio will be beautified on 22 May 2022 at Lyon, France, another stage towards her canonisation as a Saint. She created the Association of the Faith in 1822. The charity is now known as Missio APF.

Pauline believed that if we all dedicate ourselves to praying a little, and giving a little, we can help share God's love throughout the world.

This approach continues to give momentum to Missio's work today. She had a comfortable life but, as a teenager fell and damaged her mobility permanently.

She committed herself to small acts of mercy. She gave away her finery and began to visit those living in poverty and in hospices. She also taught the faith to silk workers. At 19 years old, she started the penny collection with her father's employees, which in 1936 became the red box collection. The aim was to collect change and share it amongst those who need it. A little can go a long way., From Pauline's foundations, Missio and the Mill Hill Missionaries continue to build a vibrant missionary family around the world. Thank you all for your continued prayers and generosity for helping to bring practical and spiritual help to those most in need.
