Dear Parishioners, dear friends,

That mystery of light *par excellence*, the Transfiguration, has always been a favourite for me. I was received into the Catholic Church, confirmed and received my first Holy Communion on the feast, which is celebrated on 6 August. Every Second Sunday of Lent we also revisit this mystery as we hear the gospel of the Transfiguration in either Matthew, Luke and this year Mark.

The mysteries of Our Lord never stand alone, they are beautifully connected and inform the whole mystery of His life, death and Resurrection. This mystery seems to have more to do with resurrection than anything, but its place in the gospels clearly prepares the disciples for all that Jesus will endure. In the light of His face, they find strength to journey with the Lord to His cross.

Years ago my friend Fr Dominic undertook a pilgrimage along a stretch of the Camino de Santiago. He had a wonderful time of profound prayer and happy meetings. Some months later, facing a terminal diagnosis he reflected that the powerful experience of the Camino had prepared him for all he was to face. Dominic had resolved to be useful in Edinburgh and knew he would die there. Relatively well, he stayed with me in Oxford and I organised fun things for us to do. He embraced them all, stayed up late, but was always the first in the chapel in the early morning. He made his plans to drop off his possessions as he journeyed north, giving his car away in Yorkshire and taking a train and a bag for his final stretch. In Edinburgh he sat in the cathedral confessional and said Mass in the evening until he could no longer do so. His camino transfiguration was a constant point of spiritual reference for him.

When we suffer and feel wretched, when life seems a burden and just too challenging, our climbing days of consolation and peace are a sort of reserve on which we draw. God has been powerfully present to us in such moments, but He is also there in the worst we have to face. That was the experience of His Son and His Son's disciples and dear Fr Dominic.
