Windows 2nd Collection 19th/20th February

The cost of the windows for the Back of the church is £7289.00. The price of the two large windows for the front of the Church in aluminium is £4615.00

The total cost for all the windows is £11,904.00. So we still need £1114.39 to match the difference required. So not far from our goal! Thank you so much for all the contributions so far and for your future donations! All your efforts show what a wonderful community we have in this parish.
