Learn about our fascinating local history

Most of you will know about Mount Felix, the long-since demolished mansion house by Walton Bridge that was used as a hospital for Injured New Zealand soldiers during WW1. But what is less well known is that on the same site, prior to Mount Felix there was an equally grand house called Walton House and that was the home of Emma, Countess Tankerville. Her husband, the Earl, is known for famously introducing the middle stump into a cricket wicket. But his fame overshadows that of his wife who in the late 1700s and early 1800s was one of Britain's most important botanists - a science pioneer in a world dominated by men.

This week, until 9 July, you can visit an exhibition of her work and her beautiful botanical drawings - the originals are held at Kew Gardens - at the Robert Philips Gallery at the Riverhouse Barn and on Saturday 9 July at 10.30am the exhibition curator, June Watson will be giving a fascinating talk about Lady Emma's life and work from her home here in Walton. The exhibition and the talk are free, but you should reserve places for the talk on the Riverhouse Barn website -

June, lives and works in Northumberland so this is a very rare chance to hear about a fascinating part of our local history from her first hand.
