## Parish News

### First Holy Communions

### The Parish Pastoral Council

The Parish Pastoral council (PPC) met in person in the presbytery on 28<sup>th</sup> June, and next meets on 18 July.

This meeting focused on finalising the **parish survey**, which will take place at all masses **on the weekend of July 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup>**. The survey will be based on 5 short questions, focussing on:

- Your opinion on how welcoming you find our parish/the mass
- Your reflection on our parish mission statement
- What areas of parish life you would like the PPC to prioritise.

To include as many of our community as possible, all parishioners will be encouraged to complete the questionnaire during mass. If you won't be at mass that week, you will be able to complete the questionnaire in your own time (it can be downloaded from the website and copies will be in the back of church), or online. Further details will be provided in next week's newsletter.

Lucy Jardine, the PPC Chair, will share more details about the survey and the Parish Pastoral Council in person at all masses this weekend.

The meeting also discussed a number of other pastoral matters, including the PPC guidelines and Parish mission statement. These documents are now complete and will be available online and in the back of church. All feedback is welcome.

It was also confirmed that the secondary glazing for the hall will be installed over the summer break and that a new Alpha course will be starting in September. More information will be forthcoming on the Alpha course soon.

### Audio system update

A big thank you to Peter Rose, the professional sound engineer from Epsom who came and helped set to our new audio mixer and microphones. The new fully digital system replaced many analogue units collected over 25 years. We think the sound has improved considerably. We are now in live testing mode and would welcome comments.

#### **Celebrating the Feast of St Joachim and St Anne – Saturday 22 July 2.30pm at Arundel Cathedral**

Pope Francis has offered his thoughts on the Feast of St Joachim and Anne. He says "I would invite you to make a concrete gesture that would include grandparents and the elderly. Let us not abandon them. Their presence in families and communities is a precious one, for it reminds us that we share the same heritage and are part of a people committed to preserving its roots. From the elderly we received the gift of belonging to God's holy people. The Church, as well as society, needs them, for they entrust to the present the past that is needed to build the future. Let us honour them, neither depriving ourselves of their company nor depriving them of ours. cast aside! The World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly is meant to be a small but precious sign of hope for them and for the whole Church."

As a Diocese we will celebrate this day with Mass followed by refreshments afterwards in the cathedral centre. Please come with the older generation to celebrate the gift of their presence in your family and in your parish. **Gatwick Detainees Welfare Group** supports asylum seekers and other migrants who are held in immigration detention at Gatwick. Some of those held arrive with only the clothes they are wearing. The charity gives out good quality second-hand men's clothes and would be extremely grateful for laundered donations.

The clothes they need are: Tracksuit bottoms: M, L, XL, XXL. T-shirts: S, M. Jeans: 32", 34", 36". Trousers: 32". Trainers: 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 (40-45). They do not give out second-hand underwear.
