WELCOME TO MASS Readings and prayers are found in the Parish Missals for The Twenty Second Sunday in ordinary time.

This week we celebrate the feast of three great women of the Faith who gave their lives rather than deny Jesus Christ and His Holy Church. Margaret Clitherow, Ann Line and Margaret Ward are honoured at the altar this Tuesday.

The story of Margaret Clitherow made a great impression on me when I was a little boy. The children's programme Blue Peter ran a series on women saints and Margaret Clitherow was amongst them. I wonder whether editorial policy would allow such a telling of a story such as Margaret's on today's TV.

The Pearl of York, Margaret was a beautiful young woman. Born Middleton, she was brought up a protestant in King Henry's new church. Margaret became a Catholic in the 1570s, but was married to the Shambles butcher, John Clitherow who also had the civic responsibility of reporting Catholics. Margaret ceased going to the established church and was arrested three times, eventually spending two years in prison. She used her time well, steeping

herself in stories of Catholic persecution and learning Latin for her prayers.

Margaret's downfall came when she was convicted for giving refuge to priests, hiding the necessary thing for celebration of Holy Mass and teaching the catechism of the Catholic Margaret's trial was summary and she refused to plea to save her children from possible torture and being called to testify. Her stance also meant that family property stayed with her husband and children. Remaining resolutely silent in her trial, she was sentenced to be gradually crushed to death in the most brutal way. Margaret was pregnant with her fourth child.

One of Margaret's sons became a priest. Devoted to her children, she is now counted amongst the company of the heavenly family of the saints. The baptistery at St Barnabas is dedicated to Margaret Clitherow and there is a beautiful statue of her there. She is also patroness of the Union of Catholic Mothers, for whose members we will especially pray on her Tuesday feast day.

May God bless those mothers who are called to protect and defend their children in extraordinary and heroic ways.
