Abolition of Modern Slavery

On Wednesday 8th February we celebrate the feast day if St Josephine Bakhita born in 1869 in the Darfur region of Sudan. She was captured as a child by Arab slave traders and was bought and sold many times over until she ended up miraculously with the Canossian sisters in Italy who introduced her to Jesus. She chose freely to become a nun. She was Canonised in 2000 by Pope John Paul II. She is venerated in both the Catholic and Anglican Church. Ann Meehan a parishioner from St Erconwald's church in Walton on Thames will be talking on Radio Maria on the 8th February at 10.00am as part of their Just Life programme. Ann will be bringing awareness that Slavery still exists here today in the UK on our doorstep. She is part of a team of Ecumenical ambassadors (Catholic and Anglican) working together to spread the word and take positive action to prevent a crime which is often hidden in plain sight. Please support Ann by listening in to Radio Maria on the 8th Feb at 10.00 am. There will be an opportunity in the last 20 minutes of the programme for discussion and questions.
