Dear Parishioners, dear friends,

Most of us operate our week with a routine. On Monday we clean the kitchen, on Wednesday we get the shopping, on Friday we eat fish and chips and on Saturday we change the bed linen. Routine is an important part of necessary work: it helps us know what should be done and gives us incentive for doing it.

This week is Holy Week. We take a break from the humdrum and the everyday and enter passionately into the mystery of the Passion of the Lord. A good Holy Week will involve the investment of not just our time but also our emotions. In the familiar phrases of the passion gospels we enter into the life of Jesus and glimpse again the power of His life to bring salvation.

The week begins with the triumphant welcome of the Lord into Jerusalem. It becomes clear to us that Jesus has gone up to Jerusalem for the single purpose of offering Himself, the Lamb without spot or blemish, for the life of the world. He asserts His authority over the Temple and in His Body we sense the new and eternal

covenant which He will bring about by His death.

The Easter Triduum begins with the Mass of the Lord's Supper. We recall how the Lord washed the feet of His disciples and gave them the gift of Himself in the Holy Eucharist. We learn that we are feed by the life and love of the Lord.

After the Gloria of the Mass all falls silent, there are no bells and eventually the church is stripped. Only a quiet corner of repose, beautifully decorated and ablaze with candle light, recreates for us the Garden of Gethsemane.

The Liturgy of Good Friday begins in silence and there is a dramatic procession to the stripped altar when the priest prostrates himself on the altar step and the faithful kneel. The Passion is proclaimed and the crucifix is unveiled for our veneration.

On Holy Saturday night a fire is prepared and a candle blessed. The candle, a symbol of the risen Christ, is processed into the dark church as we proclaim Lumen Christi, Christ our light. We renew the promises of baptism and resolve to serve God as faithful members of the Church.

Last year we were deprived of our Easter ceremonies. I shall never forget marking those key points in the liturgy in an empty church. This year we treasure our opportunity for a good Holy week with added enthusiasm and that investment of time, as well as heart and mind.
