So far, we have collected £11.563.73. The cost of the windows for the back of the Church is £7289.00. The price of the two large windows for the front of the Church in aluminium is £4615.00

The total cost for all the windows is £11.904.00. All your efforts show what a wonderful community we have in this parish.
