The Parish Pastoral Council

As you will be aware, the Parish Pastoral Council (PPC) ran a survey in July to understand more about our parish community and to capture feedback on areas of parish life to help the PPC prioritise its efforts. In total, there were 178 survey responses covering 284 parishioners in total (58 responses covered 2 or more parishioners) – so firstly thank you to everyone who took the time to complete the survey!

There were two areas that clearly emerged as priorities from the list presented in the survey, with around 30% of responses picking out "Youth" and "Young Family" in their "Top 3" priorities. Other priorities, including adult formation, also featured. Caring for the sick & elderly was also highlighted in the "Other" category where parishioners could suggest additional priorities.

The PPC is working on these priorities, in addition to the theme of "Welcoming" - being a welcoming parish - which it had already identified as a focus area. A key time for our parish community is Advent and Christmas, and several activities and events are being planned - more to follow next week!
