*Dear Parishioners, dear friends,*

*This week we celebrate the 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the  
consecration of our Cathedral at Arundel. Even  
though the church has only been a cathedral since  
the foundation of the diocese in 1965, the church  
was finished 150 years ago.*

*Arundel is a beautiful town, a city set on a hill,  
and the cathedral stands as a beacon of the presence  
of Almighty God which surrounds us all. Who can  
fail to notice its wonderful structure and the fleche,  
pointing like an arrow, to heaven?*

*In 1868 Duke Henry, the fifteenth Duke of  
Norfolk, commissioned the architect Hansom so  
design this new church. Hansom, of the cab fame,  
was a prolific church architect. He produced a  
building in the French Gothic style of which we are  
all so fond*

*In 1971, following the canonisation of St Philip  
Howard, the shrine to our martyr saint was set up  
and the cathedral rededicated to the other Philip (it  
had previously been St Philip Neri, Apostle of  
Rome). Now the two Philips, so different and yet*
