***WELCOME TO MASS*** *Readings and

*My dear Parishioners, dear friends*

The grave of Queen Elizabeth II is very simple. Her remains lay in a vault in St George's Chapel Windsor, with her parents and her husband - a vault enclosed by a simple stone adorned with the badge of the Order of the Garter, together with the names and dates of the deceased. I found the visit very moving and was able to find a little quiet time to say my prayers for Her late Majesty's eternal peace.

In death we are all equal, but surely in life too. The life of every human being is of infinite value because it is, simply put, human life. It seems unthinkable to many of us that the life of a tiny child waiting to be born is considered dispensable; but now Parliament may well be set to debate a bill to extend, up to full term, the possibility of an abortion, so that the life of a developed child in the womb can be seen as either a gift or a hindrance, depending on whim.

Most of us try to be attentive to the circumstances of others. We know that an

extra mouth to feed can be a real hardship for many, we know too that the circumstances; but pregnancies are far from the loving norm of family life about which we love to hear; but surely the responsibility is on all of us to nurture a culture of life and the quality of human living, so that life is cherished in all its stages not just as God's gift but also as a basic human right.

Just as we look back on horrific periods of human history, I wonder how future generations will look back on us? Will they regard the killing of the unborn child as a good choice and as progress?

As I searched for the Society for the Protection of Unborn Children to find out more about this proposed legislation a variety of options came up - the protection of ancient buildings, animals abroad, to name but two, and eventually children. May this Lent be a time of blessing, not least in the lives of the most vulnerable. May our prayers and basic sense of justice, as well as our generosity, champion life in all its stages.
