My dear Parishioners

Lent begins this Wednesday 2 March and now is the time to make the decision about how we are to keep the Holy Fast.

There seems to be an urgency about so many aspects of our lives: bills to pay, moves to be made, schools to be chosen, proposals to be made. Sometimes we think of Lent as an urgent time.

I often reflected that I've not kept a good Lent and perhaps lacked the sense of its urgency. This year I'm trying a different approach. This year I plan to relax into the season and take each day as it comes. This year I plan to wake up every morning with a sense that this new day is another Lenten Day. This year I plan to rely less on the company of others and more on the company of Almighty God. The days actually lengthen during the season of Lent and I plan to mark them in a very different way from the way I normally live.
