#### Storytime

It has been wonderful to see so many of our children back in school this week for their End of Year Storytime sessions with their class teachers. The children were all delighted to be back and teachers were delighted to see them. There was lots of excited chatter and many happy faces! We look forward to the final sessions of Storytime next week, before welcoming back the whole of Year 6 for the final week of term.

# **Virtual Sports Day**

Thank you too for the enthusiastic response to our Virtual Sports Day today. Thank goodness the rain held off this morning! We have received photos and videos of the children at home competing in their events and the bubbles in school have also been timed and measured competing in the same events. This morning, we took all the children in school out in their bubbles on the field to complete the last two events – Egg and Spoon and Sprint – together, competing against the clock and their classmates at home. Although in no way reminiscent of the wonderful Sports Day events we have with all the families gathered on the field to support their children, the children wore their house colours and enjoyed representing their houses, just like the children at home! It would be lovely to receive more video or photo footage of the children competing at home if you have it – by sending it in to school, you are giving permission for us to share the photo with the school community. Mr Joice will collate the results submitted from home and from school and will calculate the winning house, as well as event winners in each class. We will share the results with you early next week, once all the information has been gathered.

## Reports

End of year academic reports will be coming out to you next week as well. As you can imagine, it has been an interesting exercise for teachers compiling these, with no end of year national assessments and children both in school and at home completing slightly different work than they would normally be completing at this time of year! In common with other schools, we are reporting on the situation as it was up to March, before the lockdown, rather than having unequal assessments of children in all their different situations right now. A letter will come out with the reports explaining this further, but please don't worry about it. Results nationally will not be counted for this summer and we are well prepared to support our children back in school in September.

#### **Summer Camps**

As you will be aware, Planet Soccer are running Summer Camps for 4 weeks of the summer holidays at Cardinal Newman and bookings are now open. They anticipate high demand for these weeks, so it would be worth booking up quickly if you are hoping to use these.

#### **School Reopening**

Yesterday's Primary School guidance for September looks very promising, allowing us to take back all of our children in bubbles of 30, with some restrictions on staggered starts and lunchtimes. Wraparound Care (Whizz Kids) will also be able to open within the guidance from September and again, we will be in touch to confirm places and share further details before the end of term. Thank you for your patience while we consider the best way of implementing the guidance for our school community.
