Parish News

First Holy Communions

Many congratulations to the children that had their First Holy Communion yesterday in our Church. Another step in their Catholic path.

2 more First Holy Communions to go (17th and 24th of June), Fr Ruslan will be celebrating First Holy Communions in our Church. They will be at 2pm. Please pray for the children and their families as they take this very important step in their Catholic Faith.

For the next 3 weeks there will be NO Saturday 9.30am Mass.

The Parish Pastoral Council

The Parish Pastoral council (PPC) met in person in the Presbytery on 25th May. The members reviewed and discussed the proposed St Erconwalds mission statement ("a brief and clear mission statement makes a public declaration about the parish's purpose and helps keep priorities in order to build morale and provide direction for the future") which is currently:

"To grow in faith, love and community"

The intention is to ask the parishioners to reflect and comment on this via a survey that will be carried out in July. In addition, the survey will ask parishioners to provide an indication which activities and programmes they would like the PPC to focus on. There will be more information about the survey in the upcoming newsletters and during masses.

Other items that were discussed included confirmation that the secondary glazing has been ordered for the hall and that the AV upgrade (Televisions at the front of the church) is ongoing. In addition, a quote of £26,000 has been received to address the damp in the church. The initial assessment indicates that the damp has been caused by general dilapidations as opposed to structural issues.

Due to the increased energy costs and need to address the damp, the Parish is currently budgeting to make a loss this year, and so will need to take out a loan to meet the additional building maintenance costs (e.g. addressing the damp). Additional fund-raising activities were discussed e.g. St Erconwald's has got talent in the summer, which will also help address the deficit.
