Some Reception Classroom Routines and General Information



Snack Time: fruit / vegetables and water

At morning break time the children can take in a piece of uncooked fruit or vegetable with a drink of water.

All fruit or containers and water bottles should be named.

Children will be given a piece of fruit each afternoon in school.

Reading Folders: taken into school each day

These need to be taken to school each day as we often send information home in the reading folders.

Uniform/Clothing

All clothing must be named and cardigans/jumpers should have a loop sewn in so they can be hung from the pegs.

For PE children will need red shorts, a blue PE t-shirt and a pair of plimsolls in a PE bag. These should be kept in school every day. The timetable will be given to you at the beginning of term which will show when children have PE.

A painting apron will be needed and can be kept in the PE bag. Children are taken outside in light drizzle; a waterproof coat/jacket should be in school daily.

Coming to and leaving the classroom: classroom door into the playground

Children come from the playground into the class through their own classroom door at the beginning of the session during the induction period and also when children begin school.

They are also collected by parents from this door at the end of the day.

Collecting children: inform staff of any changes before the end of the day

Parents need to let the Reception staff know if anybody, other than a parent, will be collecting their child from school.

Each classroom has a book in which parents can write any changes to who will be picking up their child.
