CAFOD Family Fast Day – Friday 5 October

CAFOD's theme this year is 'Brighten Up", here is a quote taken from the campaign: Sadly, due to poverty and injustice, this harvest will not be bright for millions of children and young people around the world who will miss out on food, clean water and even on going to school. But your support is helping to change this! Last year, schools around England and Wales joined us to **Brighten Up** and help make the world a brighter place for communities living in extreme poverty.
