





The Promenade Choirs rehearse at Bell Farm School in Hersham and are recognised as one of the top choral ensembles for young singers living in Elmbridge and beyond. The choirs put on a concert every term and take part in several local festivals each year. They are non-auditioned ensembles, catering for singers aged from 7 to 21 years, and offer members top quality musical and technical guidance directed by Christopher Goldsack.

Christopher has been an international singer of distinction but chose to further his career in education. He founded the Promenade Choirs in 2008, and has since built a reputation for excellence. The repertoire for the choirs is extraordinarily varied and ranges from major Classical works, such as Handel's *Messiah* and Rutter's *Feel the Spirit*, to contemporary Popular and Music Theatre songs.

The atmosphere in the choirs is welcoming and fun. Though members are challenged to stretch themselves this is done in a very supportive way, and help is always available.

The **Junior Choir** caters for boys and girls from 7 or 8 years old and rehearses from 6.30 to 7.45pm on Monday evenings. Experienced members of the Youth Choir will mentor and support new members to ensure they feel welcome.

The **Youth Choir** caters for young singers from 11 or 12 years old and above and rehearses from 7.45 to 9pm on Monday evenings.

Financial support is available, so membership is genuinely open to all ambitious young singers.
