



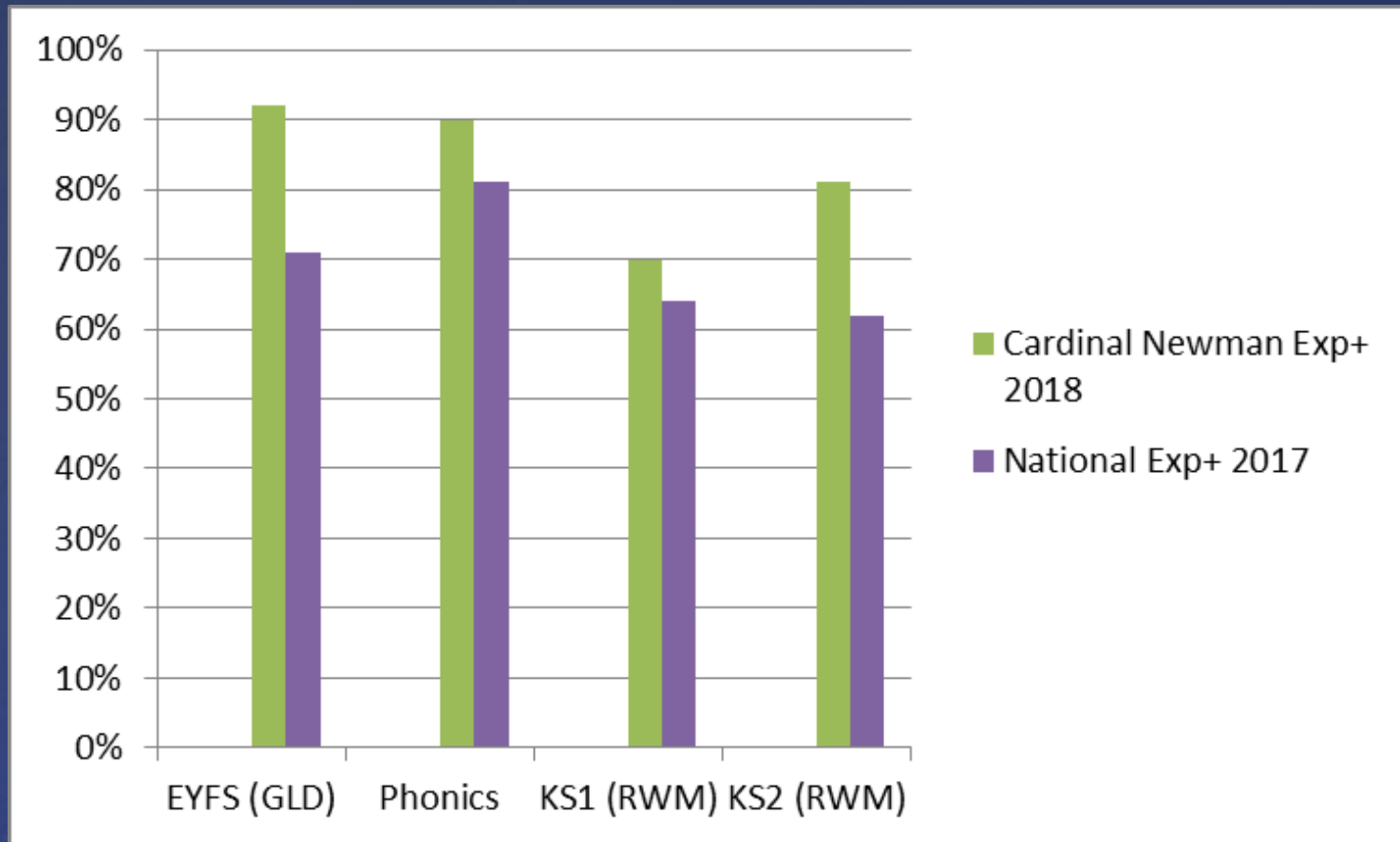

- ▶ To share our learning with our families and friends



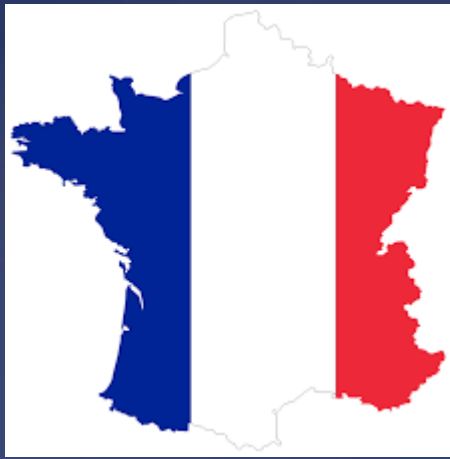

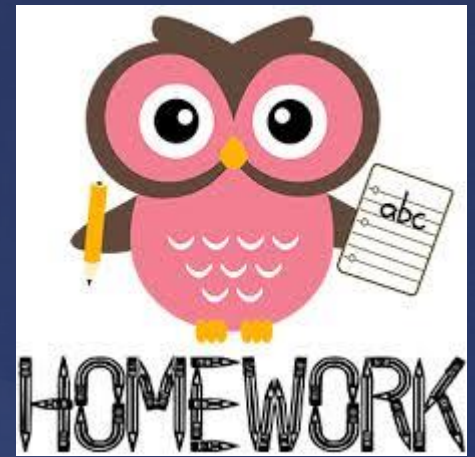
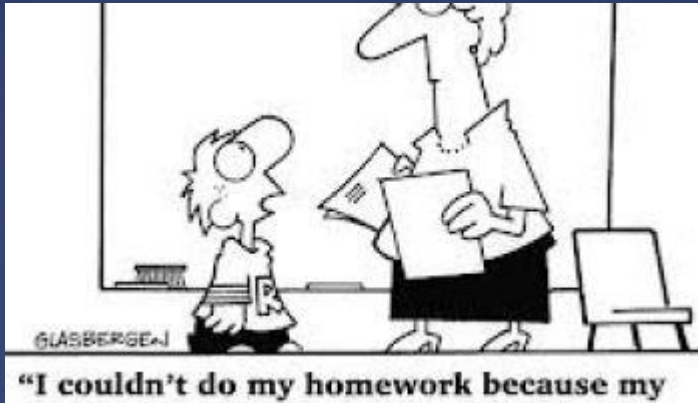
- & Music as part of our Creative Arts carousel: Art, Music and DT

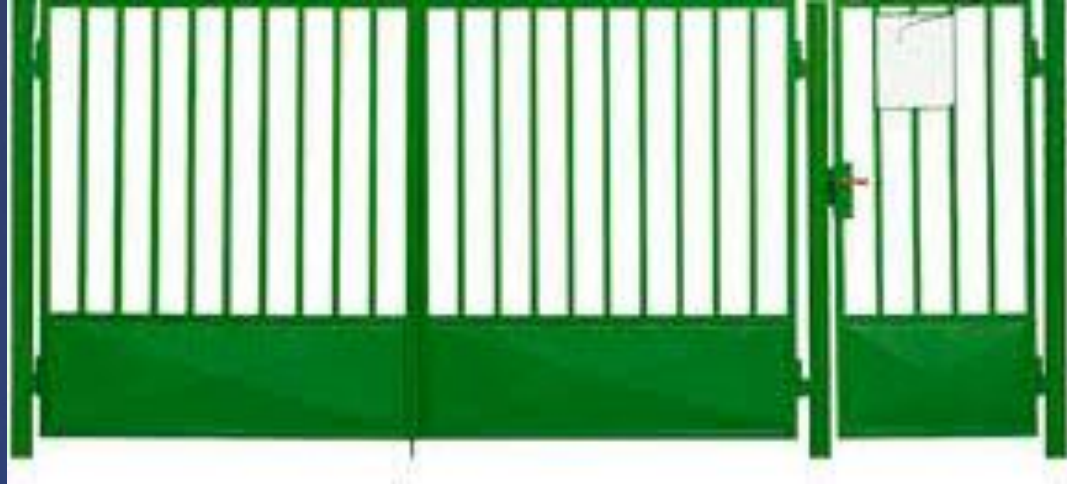
