As we approach the Easter holidays, the children and staff have enjoyed a busy Holy Week in school. It has been delightful to hear them talking about the Easter Story and discussing their plans for celebrating Easter. The Diocesan RE Adviser visited yesterday and praised the children's exemplary behaviour and their high levels of religious literacy. The children she interviewed (some of Y5 and 6 Prayer Council) told her, "I am proud to come to Cardinal Newman School because children are taught to respect each other." We look forward to welcoming them to the team.

It only remains to wish all of you a very happy and blessed Easter. I hope you will enjoy some wonderful time together as a family and I look forward to hearing all the children's exciting news on our return to school.
