This week in assemblies, we have remembered especially those who have died trying to bring peace to our world, both during the World Wars and more recently. Some children, especially those who are involved with Girlguiding or Scouts, may be taking part in Remembrance events locally over the weekend and we encourage them to bring in a photo or to tell us about their experiences.

Today in school, the children have worn blue to launch our Anti-Bullying Week. Anti-Bullying Week is a national event which helps children celebrate being themselves and to know what to do if they are being bullied. At Cardinal Newman, we are very fortunate to have a caring community of friends, but we are keen to support the national focus and to ensure children would know what to do if bullying were to occur. All Different, All Equal. Throughout next week, the children will have different activities around the theme of anti-bullying and, as always, we would encourage you to talk to your child about what they have been learning.
