Dear Parents

A huge thank you to all of you for your tremendous support for our "Come Read With Me" initiative this week. It has been lovely to have the warm buzz of happy voices around school as the children have engaged in reading with their mums, dads, grandmas,



grandpas, aunties, uncles and friends! Lots of the children have told us how much they enjoyed having family and friends in school and we hope it was a positive experience for you too. We are always keen to have more volunteer readers in school, so do please come forward if you feel you would like to come and read with the children more often. Reading is such a key skill for the children and the more practice and enjoyment they get, the better their progress! It doesn't have to be weekly – if you can commit to once per half-term, we would be delighted to have you! Please let the office know if you are interested.

Advent is almost upon us and so to the next opportunity for parents to come and join us in school! Father Bill is leading an Advent Reflection for parents and children weekly on Monday mornings from 8:15am – 8:40am starting this coming Monday 27th November (a bit early, but it means we can get the four Advent Sundays in before we break up!) All parents and all children are welcome to join us every week, so please just turn up and join us in the hall. To help the KS2 children to understand that Advent is a time of preparation and reflection (not easy when the commercial world is already full of the glitter and gifts of Christmas -time!), we are asking all of them to commit to coming at least once during Advent (if they can come every week, so much the better!). So that they can encourage each other, we have assigned each year group a week to help them definitely come along at least once. Year 3 will begin with their assigned week this coming Monday morning and we will continue as follows:

Mon 27th Nov – Year 3, Mon 4th Dec – Year 4

Mon 11th Dec – Year 5, Mon 18th Dec – Year 6

The Advent Reflection will focus on the Advent Wreath and help us to prepare more fully for the joy of Christmas which is to come. Please do come and join us – the more the merrier!

Last but not least, KS2 children have this week been invited to apply to join our new school **Prayer Council.** This is the brainchild of two of our Year 6 girls who are keen to lead activities at lunchtimes in the prayer garden and help to develop the prayer life of the school. Some keen children have already submitted their letters explaining why they would like to be a member of the Prayer Council – in order to give everyone who would like to, the chance to reply, letters are welcome until Monday evening, when the Senior Leadership Team will be deciding who would be the best children for the roles. We are keen to have representatives from across KS2, so if your child would be interested and hasn't yet applied, **do help them to write their letter this weekend!** Watch this space for further developments in the life of our brand new Prayer Council!
