Keep going and keep smiling you are all amazing



- opaque

Can you find as many different objects around your house as possible to fit into each category? You may need a torch to explore if light can pass through each object (most phones have torches, but please check with an adult before using their phones!). If you do not have a torch, record your predictions - in which category do you think each object could be placed? Produce a table to record your findings.
