Here is an outline of the work you will be doing:

English

This week we are going to continue to use the Talk for Writing units – this week you are starting a new unit. It is called 'Rainbows, Rainbows, Everywhere'. Your main piece of writing this week will be to write an information text about rainbows or something else of your choice. You can include illustrations in your piece of work.

Remember to read what you have learned about rainbows and use the information in the text to help you add detail to your information text. Or if you are using books or online sources for your chosen topic. Use your work that you have been doing throughout the week to help you.

Make sure you try your very best for your writing task. We look at them carefully each week. We want it to be your neatest handwriting. Use all of the information you have found from the different tasks to help with your writing. When you have finished your information text, self/peer assess using the success criteria and send to the email below.

Maths

In maths we will be looking at 2D and 3D shapes. We haven't done much of this in school this year however you will have done some in Year 1 and at home with your parents.

On Friday we have added a maths investigation -Please look at the activity on the website – we would like you to explore 2D and 3D shapes a little more at home. Can you make different 2d and 3D shapes at home using materials at home? We are sticking with X4 tables as they are quite tricky!
