Dear Year Three, we hope you have had a lovely half term and enjoyed the beautiful weather. Well done for working hard again over the half term! Here is an outline of what you will be getting up to this week:

English

This week we are going to start using the Talk for Writing units – children you will be familiar with using these in school. We are starting with an exciting unit called 'THE TRUTH ABOUT TROLLS'. Your main piece of writing this week will be a description of a troll. Do you remember the Troll in the story of The Three Billy Goats Gruff? Do you know any other stories that have a troll?

Start by reading the information text, The Truth about Trolls. Try to complete one of the activities each day as shown on the weekly timetable. Work your way through the activities to get all your amazing ideas ready for your description of a troll writing.

Remember to use a dictionary and thesaurus to use a range of exciting vocabulary. Don't forget to draw and label your troll first, as this will help you to write your description. Remember we did this with 'Smok' the dragon! Let your imaginations run wild. It will take several sessions to produce your final piece. Please use the 'sticker sheet' to focus on the success criteria and to self / peer assess your work. When you have finished your description, send to the year 3 email below by **8th June**.

Maths

In maths we will be looking at the relationship between 2-D shapes and angles. We will continue to use the White Rose planning for this. Use the PowerPoints to help you each day. On Friday there is a Maths investigation question for you to answer!

Try to keep up with your 'I Can do Maths' work.

On Friday we have added a maths investigation lesson (Day 5). There is a link there which will help you with the first two questions, then there is a template to help you with question three. It's a fun lesson so challenge yourself with it!
