I hope you are all well. Here is an outline of the work you will be doing this week:

#### **English**

This week we are going to continue using the Talk for Writing unit called Doors – the World of Possibility which we started before half term. It has been great to read your stories, they really made us smile. This week it would be great to see if EVERYBODY could remember to send their work in. Your main piece of writing this week will be to write a portal story – that is a story where your main character enters a door to either a magical world, a step back in time or an unusual place.

Work your way through the unit completing activities 7-11 to get ideas and then really let your imaginations go. Try to make sure you include some pattern of three sentences and some semi-colons in your writing this week.

Make every word count in your story and consider your verb choices carefully. It will take several sessions to produce your final piece . When you have finished your story, self/peer assess using the success criteria and send to the email below by 15<sup>th</sup> June.
