English

This week we are going to start another unit using the Talk For Writing Unit called, 'Journey to the Jungle'. It looks amazing and really exciting. Maybe you have been in a jungle or a deep wood. Your main piece of writing this week will be to write another poem, this time a 'list poem'. Remember to look back at your next step work from the pet poem. Use all the information and ideas you have worked through in the first three days before you start your planning and then complete the task using this information. There is also a comprehension activity to do.

Start by reading or listening to the information text, Journey to the Jungle. Try to complete one of the activities each day as shown on the weekly timetable. Work your way through the activities to get all your amazing ideas ready for your poem. It will take several sessions to produce your final piece.
