End of KS1 Assessments

- During May the children will complete end of KS1 assessments in: Reading, Grammar/ Spelling and Maths.

- 2 Maths papers, 2 Reading papers, 1 Grammar paper and 1 Spelling test.
- There will be no pressure put on children during the assessments– we will not be informing the children that they are completing assessments.

- Spellings- will start at the beginning of October. Words will be sent home on a Tuesday to learn for the following Monday.
