Daily Essential Tasks:

Year 6 daily Pitch and Expectations or Arithmetic booster books - one page per day

Possible writing Tasks based on books read:

- Letter of complaint to the author about why the ending should be different
- As a character, retell in a letter the events of a chapter to another character
- Write a 'prequel' chapter
- Compare and contrast the main character from beginning of book to end
- Rewrite a section of the story from the point of view of the villain or other character
- 'If I were the main character, I would.....'-discuss how you would act differently and why

Topic Projects:

- Begin a research project on the topic of Europe. Make your own booklet for this.
- Plan your own project. Focus on WHAT, WHEN, WHERE, WHY ,WHO - include maps / photos / information /diagrams etc.
- Within your project you may complete a mini topic and focus on one European country - include information on history, culture , places of interest, geographical features etc.
